TABLE OF PROVISIONS.

SECTION 1.	TITLE.
SECTION 2.	RIGHT TO NOT ATTEND.
SECTION 3.	FAILURE TO COMPLY.

B E IT ENACTED by this House of Commons, in this present, assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

SECTION 1. Title.

1 This Act shall be cited as “Vacation Rights Act of 2022”.

SECTION 2. Right to not attend

3 Any Member of the House has the right to refuse to
4 attend a vacation that is approved by the House.

SECTION 3. Failure to comply.

7 If the Member made clear that they did not want to
8 attend vacation, but was forced against their will, shall
9 have a ticket issued against the Sergeant-at-Arms for
10 failure to enforce this Act.
