TABLE OF PROVISIONS.

SECTION 1.	TITLE.
SECTION 2.	SPEED LIMIT.
SECTION 3.	FAILURE.

B E IT ENACTED by this House of Commons, in this present, assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

SECTION 1. Title.

1 This Act shall be cited as “Speed Limit Act”.

SECTION 2. Speed limit.

2 (a) The driveway from Range Road to before the curve of
3 the driveway, shall be set to a maximum speed of ten (10)
4 miles per hour.

5 (b) The driveway from the curve to the garage, shall be set
6 to a maximum speed of five (5) miles per hour.

7 (c) The Speaker shall establish signs on the driveway to
8 inform those of the speed limits.

SECTION 3. Failure.

9 (a) Anyone who fails to observe the speed limit can
10 encounter a fee reasonable to the speed which was
11 violated.

12 (b) If driving over the speed limit caused damage to the
13 property, but was under \$1,000 in damages, the fine shall
14 include the amount of money necessary to repair the
15 damages.
