provide for landscaping funding, identifying areas subject to landscaping, establishing the preservation of property, changes to the driveway, addition of a brick pathway, installation of a pond, addition of patio, addition of trees, providing for removal of dead land, and providing for restoration efforts due to renovation damages.

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**B**E IT ENACTED by this House of Commons, in this present, assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1    **SECTION 1. Title.**

2    This Act shall be cited as the “Outdoor Advancement Act  
3    of 2022”.

4    **SECTION 2. 2022 landscaping funding.**

5    The Speaker of the House shall have up to \$25,500  
6    available up to the end of the 2022 fiscal year for the  
7    purposes of landscaping.

8    **SECTION 3. Other funding.**

9    When necessary, the House may use up to \$500,000 in  
10   order to fulfil this Act.

11   **SECTION 4. Areas subject to landscaping.**

12   (a) GENERAL LANDSCAPING CLAUSE.—The sides of  
13   the House, the west side of the House, and the front area  
14   of the House are subject to landscaping using the funds  
15   granted in this Act.

16   (b) HONOR THE LIFE OF SPARKY.—Using the funds  
17   described in § 2 of this Act must include landscaping  
18   efforts in order to preserve and honor the life of Sparky  
19   Cavinder.

20 (i) This subsection is to be completed by December  
21 2023.

22 (c) ELECTRICAL LIGHTING.—Throughout the pathway  
23 as described in § 3(b) of this Act, there shall be electrical  
24 lighting installed.

25 **SECTION 5. Preservation of property.**

26 (a) It shall be unlawful for any person to move, displace,  
27 or damage any landscaping property and shall,  
28 notwithstanding the Criminal Code Act, be subject up to  
29 \$1,000,000.

30 (b) All damage claims of personal property shall be settled  
31 under HCC §§ 2-4-2(b), 2-5-4 and are in addition to the  
32 fines in subsection (a).

33 **SECTION 6. Driveway.**

34 (a) CEMENT EDGEING.—The sides of the driveway,  
35 from the start to around the curve, shall have concert  
36 edging.

37 (i) The side of the driveway with current edging  
38 shall be replaced.

39 (b) BLACKTOP.—The sides of the driveway, from the  
40 start to around the curve, shall be replaced with blacktop.

41 (i) Funds described in this section are separate  
42 from Section 2 of this Act.

43 (c) REMOVAL OF ADDITIONAL ROCKS.—The rocks  
44 placed around the curve subject to the House Renovation  
45 Act of 2021(Public Law 212-10; as amended) shall be  
46 removed by December 2023.

47 (d) ADDITION TO THE DRIVEWAY.—By the start of the  
48 driveway, between the apple tree and the wood storage,  
49 shall be an extension of the driveway for peoples to park  
50 or back their cars in.

51 (i) FUNDING.—Funding to complete this  
52 subsection are not subject to the limits set in  
53 Section 2 of this Act.

54 (ii) The edition shall be edged (§ 5(a)) and  
55 blacktopped (§ 5(b)).

56 (iii) Shall be completed by June 2024.

57 **SECTION 7. Stone pathways.**

58 (a) From the driveway to the annex, there shall be a stone  
59 pathway that circles the west side of the House.

60 (b) This stone pathway shall connect to:

61 (i) the Deck (HCC § 2-4-4); and

62 (ii) the pathway described in § 3(b) of this Act.

63 (c) FUNDING.—Funds used to enact this Section are not  
64 subject to the funds set in § 2 of this Act.

65 **SECTION 8. Pond.**

66 (a) INSTALLATION OF POND.—Next to the power pole,  
67 their shall be installed a medium sized pond installed by  
68 whomever may be designated.

69 (b) COMPLETION DATE.—This shall be completed by  
70 June 2024.

71 (c) FUNDING.—Funds used to enact this Section are not  
72 subject to the funds set in § 2 of this Act.

73 **SECTION 9. Patio.**

74 (a) INSTLATION OF PATIO.—In the stone pathway as  
75 described in § 6 of this Act, the pathway shall be widen in  
76 the curve around the House to place a patio.

77 (b) COMPLETION DATE.—This shall be completed by  
78 June 2024.

79 (c) FUNDING.—Funds used to enact this Section are not  
80 subject to the funds set in § 2 of this Act.

81 **SECTION 10. Trees.**

82 (a) The gentlewoman, Christina Cavinder, shall be  
83 designated at selecting trees as deemed appropriate.

84 (b) FUNDING.—Funds used to enact this Section are not  
85 subject to the funds set in § 2 of this Act.

86 **SECTION 11. Removal of dead land.**

87 (a) In areas whereas there are dead or overgrown land,  
88 the gentlemen, Tim Cavinder, shall be designated at  
89 removal of such land as deemed necessary by him.

90 (b) FUNDING.—Funds used to enact this Section are not  
91 subject to the funds set in § 2 of this Act.

92 **SECTION 12. Restoration from damage caused by**  
93 **renovations.**

94 (a) In the areas damaged due to the renovations efforts  
95 under the House Renovation Act of 2021 (*Pub. L. 212-10;*  
96 *as amended*), the Speaker, in consultation with the  
97 gentlemen Tim Cavinder, and the gentlewoman,  
98 Christina Cavinder, shall take efforts to restore the land  
99 damaged due to such renovations.

100 (b) FRONT LAWN.—The House shall, once renovations  
101 are completed, shall restore the front lawn by June 2024.

102 (i) FUNDING.—Funds used to enact this Section  
103 are not subject to the funds set in § 2 of this Act.

104 **SECTION 13. Definitions.**

105 “*Landscaping*” is defined as bricks, plants, mulch, and all  
106 other decorative work completed outside.

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*Speaker of the House Assent*
