establish a department of highway management, a secretary for the agency, delegates powers of managing certain programs to the agency, and provides funding for the agency.

TABLE OF PROVISIONS.

SECTION 1.	TITLE.
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BE IT ENACTED by this House of Commons, in this present, assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 **SECTION 1. Title.**

2 This Act may be cited as “The Highway Management
3 Act”.

4 **SECTION 2. Establishment.**

5 (a) There is hereby established an Agency of the House to
6 be known as The Highway Management Agency
7 (hereafter referred in this Act as the “Agency”).

8 (b) There shall be at the head of the Agency a Secretary of
9 Highway Management (hereafter referred in this Act as
10 the “Secretary”), who shall be appointed by the Speaker,
11 with the consent of the House.

12 **SECTION 3. General provisions.**

13 (a) The House delegates certain powers to the Agency,
14 and does not require the consent of the House; unless it is
15 failed to be listed in this Act.

16 (b) The Objectives of the Agency are—

17 (1) To manage all roadways in the jurisdiction of
18 the House, and may be managed without the
19 consent of the House, such as—

20 (i) Removal of debris and clear roadways;
21 and

22 (ii) Spraying of chemicals to kill plant life
23 growing on roadways.

24 (2) To find ways to improve roadways that are cost
25 effective to the House;

26 (3) To manage separation between the roadways
27 and the natural life;

- 28 (4) Report all violations of House Code (HCC)
29 within the Agency's jurisdiction and report them to
30 the Sergeant-at-Arms; and
- 31 (5) Enact and enforce all funding, programs, and
32 other legislation passed by the House that relates
33 to the Agency, such as—
- 34 (i) Placement, change, or removal of signage
35 on the roadways;
- 36 (ii) Outdoor advancement programs; and
- 37 (iii) Ensuring that vehicles in the house
38 jurisdiction are safe to passengers.
- 39 (c) The objectives of the Secretary are—
- 40 (1) To ensure proper management of the roadways;
- 41 (2) Ensure no violations of House Code (HCC)
42 within the Agency; and
- 43 (3) Promote programs that benefit Members of the
44 House.

45 **SECTION 4. Funding.**

- 46 (a) The House grants up to \$10,000 each fiscal year to the
47 Agency for the purposes of completing its objectives.
- 48 (b) Funding in this Act does not apply to Acts passed that
49 explicating gives a funding amount.
