create a Health Advisor of the House, declare a health
emergency, and enforcement of such deceleration.

TABLE OF PROVISIONS.

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BE IT ENACTED by this House of Commons, in this present, assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 **SECTION 1. Title.**

2 (a) This Act may be cited as “Health Emergency Action
3 Act of 2022 (HEAA).”

4 **SECTION 2. Health advisor.**

5 (a) The House of Commons shall establish a Health
6 Advisor of the House.

7 (b) The Advisor shall be appointed by the Speaker and
8 shall serve for up to five (5) years from date of
9 appointment.

10 (c) The Advisor can be reappointed as warranted and does
11 not require approval from the House.

12 (d) The Speaker shall announce such appointment before
13 the House once made. An objection cannot be entertained.

14 **SECTION 3. Health emergency.**

15 (a) The Advisor has the authority to declare a health
16 emergency.

17 (b) The deceleration of health emergency shall be:

18 (i) Valid for thirty (30) days from date of issuance,
19 unless revoked by the Health Advisor before thirty
20 (30) days;

21 (ii) Announced before the House (HCC §§ 3-2-3(a)
22 (2021), 1-11-4(b) (2021)); and

23 (iii) Confined to the restraints of House of
24 Commons Code as set out from date of issuance of
25 the deceleration.

26 (c) The deceleration shall have the authority to compel or
27 require Members of the House to do certain actions to
28 limit or prevent the spread of disease within reason.

29 (d) The deceleration shall be renewed if necessary for an
30 additional thirty (30) days; and renewed as long as a
31 health emergency exists.

32 (e) A deceleration does not have the authority to:

33 (i) Amend House of Commons Code;

34 (ii) Supersede local, state, or federal laws,
35 resolutions, or other regulations; and

36 (iii) permit funding of any kind.

37 **SECTION 4. Enforcement.**

38 (a) In the times of an active deceleration, the following
39 people shall have the authority to enforce the
40 deceleration:

41 (i) The Health Advisor of the House;

42 (ii) The Speaker of the House; and

43 (iii) The Sergeant-At-Arms.

44 **SECTION 5. Definitions.**

45 (a) “*Advisor*” is defined as the Health Advisor of the
46 House.

47 (b) “*Deceleration*” is defined as the Deceleration issued by
48 the Health Advisor as described in § 3(a) of this Act.
