BE IT ENACTED by this House of Commons, in this present, assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 SECTION 1. Title.

- 2 This Act may be cited as "Perjury Act".
- 3 SECTION 2. Perjury generally.
- 4 Whoever—
- (1) having taken an oath before a person, that he or 5 she will testify, declare, depose, or certify truly, or 6 that any testimony, declaration, deposition, or 7 certificate by him or her subscribed, is true, 8 willfully and contrary to such oath states or 9 10 subscribes any material which he or she does not believe to be true; or 11 (2) in any declaration, certificate, verification, or 12 statement under penalty of perjury as permitted 13 under § 4 of this Act, willfully subscribes as true 14 any material matter which he or she does not 15
- is guilty of perjury, and shall, expect as otherwise
- 18 provided by law, be fined under this statue.
- 19 SECTION 3. Subornation of perjury.

- 20 Whoever procures another to commit any perjury is guilty
- 21 of subornation of perjury and shall be fined under this

- 23 SECTION 4. Declarations under penalty of perjury.
- 24 Whenever, under any law of the House or any rule,
- 25 regulation, order, or requirement pursuant to law, any

26	matter is required or permitted to be supported,
27	evidenced, established, or proved by the sworn
28	declaration, verification, certificate, statement, oath, or
29	affidavit, in writing of the person making the same, such
30	matter may, with like force and effect, be supported,
31	evidenced, established, or proved by the unsworn
32	declaration, certificate, verification, or statement, in
33	writing of such person which is subscribed by him or her,
34	as true under penalty of perjury, and dates, in the
35	following form:
36	(1) "I declare (or certify, verify, or state) under
37	penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and
