BE IT ENACTED by this House of Commons, in this present, assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 **SECTION 1. Title.**

2 (a) This Act may be cited as “Hood Re-establish Act.”

3 **SECTION 2. Acting out.**

4 (a) The House of Commons is permitted to find Hood
5 members.

6 (b) They are permitted to be added to the House of
7 Commons.

8 (c) They must go through at least five (5) meetings of the
9 House.

10 (d) Once they appear to be a better fit for society, they will
11 be removed from the House of Commons.

12 **SECTION 3. Definitions.**

13 (a) “*The Hood*” a gang or gangs of black people. Most
14 commonly found on the streets of poor income
15 neighborhoods and The Bronx.
