The Committee on Rules & Reform, having had under consideration House Resolution 17, by voice vote, report the same back to the House with the recommendation that the resolution be adopted.

SUMMARY OF PROVISIONS OF THE RESOLUTION

The resolution provides for consideration of HR 9, The Disclosure Reporting Act (TDRA). All points of order against consideration of the measure are waived. The bill shall be considered as read. All points of order against provisions in the measure are waived. The previous question shall be considered as ordered. One hour of debate and one motion to recommit are in order.

Finally, the resolution permits the Speaker or Speaker pro tempore, to declare the House adjourned through May 31, 2023.
