**PROVIDING FOR LOCATIONS FOR THE 2023
VACATION OF THE HOUSE.**

The Committee on Vacation, having had under consideration the 2023 Vacation, reports the following locations:

MICHIGAN;

TENNESSEE;

VIRGINIA;

WISCONSIN; and

LaSALLE COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

CHAPTER 1 – COMMITTEE CONSIDERATION

The Committee on Vacation took suggestions from Members of the House as required under 12-2-8(b) for consideration of the 2023 Vacation. On May 1, 2023, the Committee on Vacation met and considered all locations submitted subject to thirty (30) minutes of debate.

This vacation does *not* require a House Resolution of Intent (HCC § 12-2-4) under HCC § 12-2-3(c):

“The Committee is required to meet by May 29th each Session and hear, vote, and approve a vacation location for the respective summer...”

Upon the submission of each location, the Chair and Ranking Member voted. Pursuant to precedent, if both voted YEA or tied, it was considered favorably reported. If both voted NAY, it was not reported to the House. This was completed by May 11, 2023.

CHAPTER 2 – COMMITTEE'S RECOMMENDATIONS

The Committee recommends that the following locations be considered by the House of Commons and pursuant to HCC § 12-2-9, the Speaker herewith introduces a Resolution to provide for consideration of one of the following locations:

MICHIGAN;

TENNESSEE;

VIRGINIA;

WISCONSIN; or

LaSALLE COUNTY, ILLINOIS.
